

Honor Guard

The Honor Guard performs Military Honors Funeral Services for any honorably discharged veteran who requests a Military funeral through their funeral home.

Too often a veteran is not given a “Final Salute” because the family wasn’t aware that such a service existed. It is our job to make known to all veteran families that we are here to serve our departed. It is our honor and duty to provide a military send-off for a deserving veteran that offered his/her life for the good of the country.

Each Veteran family has the responsibility to notify the Funeral Director and request this service for their deceased veteran.

Not all funeral directors ask if the deceased was a veteran; consequently the veteran is laid to rest without the deserved “Final Salute.”

The “Final Salute” rendered by the American Legion Post 28 Honor Guard is a reverant and solemn service to bid farewell to our departed comrade. The final salute consists of a 3-volley salute, folding of the American flag, playing of “Taps,” and presentation of the folded flag to the next of kin.

We have performed this ceremony for many years and will continue to convey this honor as requested. We also perform at other ceremonies by presenting the Colors, and in some cases the service flags, for events such as:

- Memorial Day
- 4th of July
- Veterans Day
- Other requests for presenting the Colors

Let us not forget what these veterans did to preserve our freedom.
